SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations have been established for the benefit of all users of the Swimming Pool to assure the safe operation of the pool facility and to provide enjoyable recreation for all. Members are requested to cooperate in observing these rules and to obey the instruction of the Pool Attendants / Life Guards. Members violating swimming rules are subject to the revocation of their swimming privileges.

The Pass Christian Yacht Club reserved the right to refuse admittance in to the swimming facility when the capacity of the pool has been reached or when otherwise deemed necessary for the health, welfare or safety of its patrons.

The Pool Managers or their designated assistants are responsible for the operation of the pools. Their instruction must be followed at all times. Should a disagreement arise, patrons are advised to contact the Club Manager.

GENERAL RULES / ADMISSION POLICIES

1. No one is allowed in the pool area without a lifeguard on duty.
2. Proper swim attire must be worn in and at the pool area at all times.
3. The Pass Christian Yacht Club assumes no liability for injuries or damages arising from the results of participation. Due to the strenuous nature of some activities the participant is advised to consult his or her physician concerning fitness to participate. All activities present certain inherent risks and hazards which the participant assumes.
4. Management may close the facility due to bad weather.
5. Children ages 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Children under 6 years of age need to have a responsible person in the water with them at arm's reach at all times.
6. Use of the baby pool is restricted to children 5 years old and under. Each child must be supervised by any adult. Children must not be left unattended.
7. All refuse and waste papers must be deposited in designated receptacles.

8. No grills, gas or electric cooking devices may be brought into the pool deck.
9. A group of 6 or more individuals must contact Club management prior to coming to the pool to ensure proper service from the club.
10. Leave valuables at home. PCYC is not responsible for personal items at any time.
11. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted in the pool or surrounding area.
12. Safety considerations must be adhered to at all times. Any individual who poses a safety hazard to any other individual will be asked to vacate the property.
13. If an member with a disability needs special accommodations to use the pool, please contact the manager.
14. Any injury occurring in the pool area must be reported to the manager immediately.
15. The use of cameras, video cameras or any device containing camera equipment of any kind is prohibited in all locker rooms, bathrooms and changing facilities.
16. Infants / children who are not toilet trained and adults who are incontinent, who wish to enter any pool, must wear a clean diaper or disposable swim diaper covered by separate, rubber/vinyl pants, all of which must fit snugly around the legs and waist. If the diaper becomes soiled, this person must leave the pool immediately, and may not return until he/she has taken or been given a soap shower and has been re-covered by a new diaper with clean rubber/vinyl pants.
17. Pool attendants and lifeguards have the authority to enforce all pool rules. Members who repeatedly violate pool rules may be ejected by the manager.
18. All members entering the pool area from the playground or beach must shower before entering the pool area.
19. Any person having a skin disease, sore in inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge, communicable disease will not be permitted in the pool area. Additionally, persons having any considerable areas of exposed sub-skin tissues, open blisters, cuts, etc. are warned that these are likely to become infected. Such persons may not use the pool. Any adult or child who is experiencing even a mild case of diarrhea may not use the pool.
20. Running, boisterous or rough play, pushing, acrobatics, dunking, wrestling, splashing, yelling, diving or jumping haphazardly, snapping of towels, improper conduct causing undue

- disturbances in or about the pool area or any acts which would endanger any patron are prohibited.
21. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing nose or urinating in the pool are all actions that are prohibited.
 22. No prolonged underwater swimming for time and/or distance. Competitive and/or repetitive breath holding can be deadly and is not permitted. Hyperventilation is absolutely not permitted.
 23. Single groups shall not monopolize a particular area of the pool and thereby limit its use by or intimidate other patrons. Only PCYC scheduled classes, team activities, or rental groups are permitted. Private group uses are not permitted during a Recreation Swim period and must be scheduled as a private rental.
 24. Wearing eyeglasses in the pool is discouraged unless absolutely necessary. Non-breakable lenses and frames are necessary for safety.
 25. Gum chewing is not permitted anywhere in the pool complex for health and safety reasons.
 26. NO DIVING ALLOWED.
 27. Coast Guard approved and labeled personal floatation devices, such as vests designed to provide vertical support, may be worn with permission of the Manager. Water wings (swimmies) may also be worn.
 28. Headphones must be worn when listening to musical or entertainment devices.
 29. If the overhead pool lights go off, the pool will be cleared immediately and not reopened until the light is fully restored.
